If you care for a family member or friend with a disability, medical condition, mental illness, or who is frail due to age, Barwon Health Carer Support Carer Gateway offers support and services to unpaid carers living across the Barwon South West region of Victoria. Our team works closely with carers to assist them in their caring journey and to support their physical and emotional wellbeing. Every caring journey is unique and the supports we provide are based on individual needs and circumstances of each carer.

We are funded by the Victorian Government (Support for Carers Program) and Australian Government (Carer Gateway and Commonwealth Home Support Program) to provide flexible support options to carers in our region. Barwon Health's delivery of Carer Gateway services is in partnership with Merri Health.

We encourage anyone who is in a caring role to call 1800 422 737 or visit carergateway.gov.au to get support that is right for you. Emergency respite is available 24/7 on the same number. And if you know a carer, let them know it's OK to ask for support and tell them about Carer Gateway.



Great news for carers when you need to fill up the fuel tank!

Victorian Carer Card holders can access fuel discounts through a new partnership with United Petroleum. The Department of Families, Fairness and Housing (DFFH) has announced that Victorian Carer Card holders can register for a digital or plastic United fuel discount card. This will allow them to save 4 cents per litre on fuel at United service stations across Australia.

Visit the Victorian Carer Card website <u>www.carercard.vic.gov.au</u> to check eligibility requirements and apply online. You can also contact the DFFH Carer Card team at carercard@dffh.vic.gov.au or call 1800 901 958 if you would like an application form sent to you.

Stay safe in extreme heat this summer.



During extreme heat it is easy to become dehydrated or for your body to overheat.

Extreme heat can affect anybody however the people most at risk:

- are aged over 65 years, especially those living alone
- have a medical condition such as diabetes, kidney disease or mental illness

COPING WITH THE HEAT

- Drink plenty of water, even if you don't feel thirsty (if your doctor normally limits your fluids, check how much to drink during hot weather).
- Keep yourself cool by using wet towels, putting your feet in cool water, and taking cool (not cold) showers.
- Spend as much time as possible in cool or air-conditioned buildings.
- Block out the sun at home during the day by closing curtains and blinds
- Keep in touch with sick or frail friends and family.

Call those at risk at least once a day on extreme heat days.

- Offer to help family, friends and neighbours who are aged over 65 or have an illness by doing shopping or other errands so they can avoid the heat. Take them somewhere cool for the day or have them stay the night if they are unable to stay cool in their home.
- If you observe symptoms of heat-related illness, seek medical help

PREPARE FOR EXTREME HEAT

Stock up on food, water and medicines so you don't have to go out in the heat.

Visit your doctor to check if changes are needed to your medicines during extreme heat.
